**Adult Baptism Session** is the preparation which any parent of a child to be baptized or which the godparents must undergo. This 2 hour session from 1:00 – 3:00 pm is a time to explore the roles and responsibilities of godparents, identify the spiritual hopes and dreams for the child, discuss how Baptism is a commitment to God and God's Church, explore the Catholic understanding of the Communion of Saints and of original sin, discuss the significance of the baptismal promises and symbols, and learn how Baptism makes us priest, prophet and king. Concrete instructions for the day of baptism are also given at this time.
